New meter benefits

The Itron/Tantalus metering system offers a number of benefits to our members and to the cooperative:

- Integration with our Outage Management System (OMS), which is not a feature of our current metering system.
- Faster outage response due to the integration and automatic reporting from the meter to OMS software. With Itron/Tantalus, if a meter stops working, it will immediately report the stoppage to us.
- Faster isolation of the cause of outages.
- Timelier member information for you and the cooperative—refreshed every 15 minutes through SmartHub rather than the current 24 hours.
- Even more accurate and reliable information in the field.
- More opportunity for load management.
- Meter demand information. This measures the peak amount of electricity required at any time during the month.
