

# Planning for a new or upgraded HVAC system? Consider electric heat!

If you are in the market for an HVAC system, consider electric resistance heat (an electric furnace, baseboard heaters, a wall heater, heated floors) or a heat pump—geothermal or air source. Or maybe a hybrid system would better meet your needs. For example, if you choose to install a gas furnace, it might be beneficial to add mini-splits to some areas of your home.

Members who have a separate heat meter pay less for their heating during cooler months of October through April. Those with a heat pump also pay less during the warmer months of May through September. This makes a difference when you consider that heating your home is typically 29 percent of your utility bill, according to the Department of Energy.
